X Travel Documents

- Passport Validity
 - o Ensure it's valid for at least 6 months beyond your planned return date.
- Visa Documentation
 - o Check if you need to bring additional documents for immigration.
- Flight Booking Confirmation
 - Save digital and print copies of your itinerary.
- Travel Insurance Documentation
 - o Confirm coverage includes medical, liability, and trip cancellation.

Accommodation

- Secure Housing
 - o Consider options like student housing, Airbnb, co-living, or intern housing programs.
- Understand Lease Terms
 - Check deposit requirements, duration, and rules.
- Know Your Route to the Workplace
 - o Research public transportation options and commute times.
- Check Neighborhood Safety & Accessibility
 - Research local amenities like grocery stores and pharmacies.
- Furnishing Needs
 - o Determine what essentials to bring vs. buying locally.
- Wi-Fi and Utilities Setup
 - o Confirm if these are included or need to be arranged separately.

👜 Work Preparation

Confirm First Day Details

o Date, time, meeting point, and dress code.

• Understand Dress Code

o Business formal, business casual, uniform requirements, etc.

Pack Work-Appropriate Clothing

o Include weather-appropriate items for the season.

• Work Equipment

o Confirm if a laptop, notebook, and office supplies are provided.

• Review Company Policies/Handbook

o Familiarize yourself with any materials shared beforehand.

Know Your Role & Expectations

Understand your goals, reporting structure, and tasks.

= Finance

Open a Local Bank Account

• Research if this is needed; some employers can assist.

• Bring Some Local Currency

o For immediate expenses upon arrival.

• International Debit/Credit Card

o Ensure it's activated for overseas use and notify your bank.

Budget Plan

o Create a budget for accommodation, food, transport, and leisure.

Stipend Details

o Confirm amount, payment schedule, and currency.

💼 Health & Safety

• Travel Insurance With Medical Coverage

• Ensure your policy covers medical expenses abroad.

Vaccinations

o Check if any are required or recommended for your destination.

Prescription Medications

o Bring a sufficient supply with translated prescriptions if needed.

Register with Local Embassy

o Optional but useful in emergencies.

Emergency Medical Numbers

• Research nearest clinics/hospitals to your accommodation.

Communication & Connectivity

Local SIM Card or eSIM Plan

• Research options for data and calls.

Download Essential Apps

o Maps, translation, transport, delivery, and work tools like Slack.

• VPN Subscription

• If access to certain services is restricted in your destination.

Time Zone Setup

Adjust your devices for meetings and family calls.

Packing Essentials

Adapters & Converters

For your electronics.

• Weather-Appropriate Clothing

• Research local climate for your internship period.

Work & Casual Outfits

o Pack a balance of professional and casual clothing.

• Personal Care Items

o Consider what might be difficult to find locally.

• Basic First-Aid Kit

o Include common medications you use.

Gifts or Tokens

• Small items from your home country for hosts or networking events.

📅 Cultural & Social Preparation

• Research Local Etiquette & Customs

Especially for professional settings.

• Learn Basic Phrases

o If a different language is spoken.

• Join Expat or Intern Groups

• Facebook, Meetup, Internations for social connections.

• Local Laws & Restrictions

• Research dress codes, alcohol policies, curfews, etc.

• Define skills to learn and networks to build during your internship.

• Prepare for Culture Shock

• Research differences in food, working style, and communication.
